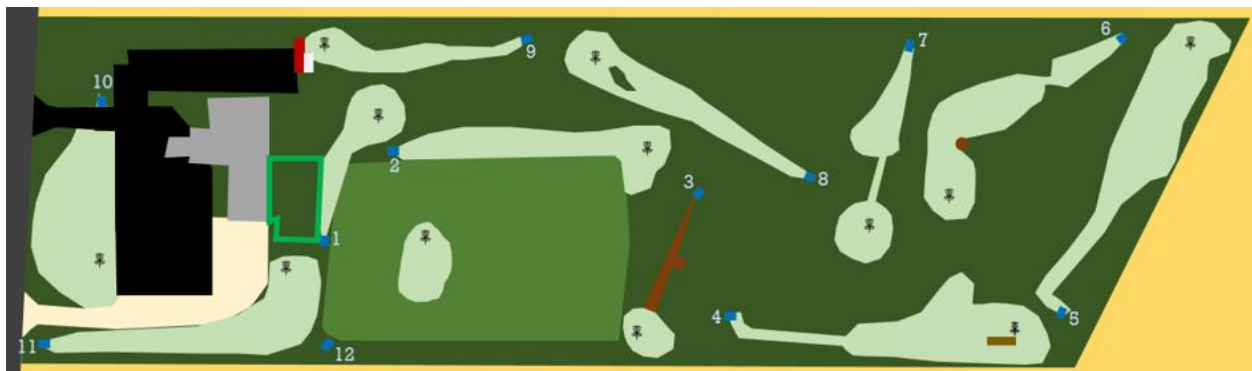

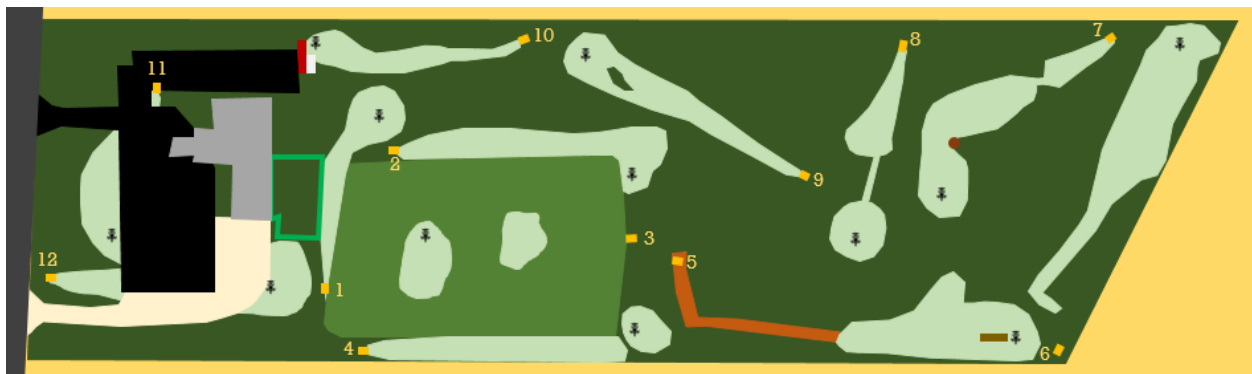
# Layouts

**\*\*Note: There are a few changes not presented in the images below: Hole 1 will not have an alternate tee for Gold. Blue 4 basket should be in Gold 5 position and vice versa. Gold 4 peninsula has more room towards end for landing\*\***

# General Rules/Regulations

All PDGA standard rules apply and specific hole rules can be found on the next pages.

All water on course is considered casual.

All fenced-in properties are OB and if you cannot safely retrieve your disc from the course property, you must leave the disc to be retrieved by staff later. Do not hop any fences/enter any property that is not on the course.

The storage facility roof and property is OB and specific holes have specific rules. Do not hop any fences/climb the storage facility fence/buildings.

Please refrain from drinking alcohol on church property and if you choose to smoke, please dispose of cigarette trash properly.

Pack out any trash you bring in!

Shirts are required, per PDGA protocol.

If you have any questions/disputes about any rulings, please: play a provisional, play out both ways to score, record both scores, and the TD will provide a final ruling after the round. Do not submit your PDGA scorecard until this is resolved.

## Order of priority on OB

1. Paint
2. Flags
3. Rope
4. Posts

# Specific Hole Rules/Regulations

## Blue Layout

**Hble 1 – 194**, Triple mandatory. Disc *must* pass below banner and between both stanchions. If missed mandatory, proceed to marked drop zone with penalty stroke. OB deep of basket. OB playground and beyond rocks on left.

**Hble 2 – 344**, OB field right designated with flags and paint. OB left and deep designated by PVC pipe markers in tall grass

**Hble 3 – 204**, True island hole. If island is missed, proceed to marked drop zone with penalty stroke. If island is missed from drop zone, normal penalty rules apply and you must continue to throw from DZ until lie on island is established. If lie on island is established and you throw OB from there, normal OB rules apply- do not go back to DZ Bricks designating island OB are considered OB

**Hble 4 – 385**, OB property right with OB line extending past fence designated by marker flags. OB tall grass left and deep designated by PVC pipe markers in tall grass.

**Hble 5 – 404**, OB property right and deep with OB line extending between properties deep of basket as designated by marker flags. OB tall grass left designated by PVC pipe markers in tall grass.

**Hble 6 – 363**, Mandatory right of telephone pole as designated. OB left designated by PVC pipes and marker flags. If missed mandatory, proceed to marked drop zone with penalty stroke. Original Hble 7 fairway and green are OB

**Hble 7 – 245**, True peninsula with island hole. Strip of fairway connecting peninsula and island is safe. If OB from the drive, proceed to marked drop zone with penalty stroke. After the drive, proceed with normal OB rules- do not go to DZ. Note: All tall grass is OB except for on the hill on the green.

**Hble 8 – 329**, OB left and deep designated by PVC pipe markers in tall grass. OB property deep.

**Hble 9 – 250**, OB left designated by PVC pipe markers in tall grass and by flags closer to the basket. OB property right. If your disc lands on/over the property on the right from the drive, proceed to marked drop zone with a penalty stroke. If OB left or deep of basket, normal OB rules apply. Parking lot is OB. Discs on top of the shipping containers are considered casual and relief can be taken from up to 1 meter from last point before landing on top.

**Hble 10 – 261**, Parking lot and any land surrounded by parking lot is OB. University Ave and beyond is OB. Gravel OB deep marked with flags. If OB at any point, proceed to marked drop zone with a penalty stroke.

**Hble 11 – 335**, Gravel. OB left marked with flags. Painted line behind stone blocks is OB. OB property right designated by fence posts- not wire. Playground is OB. Normal OB rules.

**Hble 12 – 192**, True island hole. If island is missed, proceed to DZ with penalty stroke. You must continue to throw from DZ until lie on island is established. If lie is established on island, proceed with normal OB rules.

# Specific Hole Rules/Regulations

## Gold Layout

**Hble 1 – 194**, Triple mandatory. Disc *must* pass below banner and between both stanchions. If missed mandatory, proceed to marked drop zone with penalty stroke. OB deep of basket. OB playground and beyond rocks on left.

**Hble 2 – 340**, OB field right designated with flags and paint. OB left and deep designated by PVC pipe markers in tall grass

**Hble 3 – 306**, True double island hole. If lie is not established in-bounds from the tee, proceed to marked drop zone with penalty stroke. If lie is not established in-bounds from drop zone, normal penalty rules apply and you must continue to throw from DZ until lie in-bounds is established. If lie on second island is established and you throw OB from there, normal OB rules apply- do not go back to DZ

**Hble 4 – 315**, True peninsula and island hole. OB from tee box is marked with flags on left and OB property right designated by fence posts- not wire. After peninsula, there is a small strip of OB before the normal island OB marked for original Hble 3 basket by bricks on ground. If you go OB before establishing a lie on the island, proceed to drop zone with normal penalty. Throw from DZ until lie on island is established- from there, normal OB rules apply.

**Hble 5 – 488**, OB property right and deep with OB line extending between properties deep of basket as designated by marker flags. OB tall grass designated by PVC pipe markers in tall grass

**Hble 6 – 458**, OB property right and deep with OB line extending between properties deep of basket as designated by marker flags. OB tall grass left designated by PVC pipe markers in tall grass

**Hble 7 – 363**, Mandatory right of telephone pole as designated. OB left designated by PVC pipes and marker flags. If missed mandatory, proceed to marked drop zone with penalty stroke. Original Hble 7 fairway and green are OB

**Hble 8 – 269**, True peninsula with island hole. Strip of fairway connecting peninsula and island is safe. If OB from the drive, proceed to marked drop zone with penalty stroke. After the drive, proceed with normal OB rules- do not go to DZ. Note: All tall grass is OB except for on the hill on the green.

**Hble 9 – 329**, OB left and deep designated by PVC pipe markers in tall grass. OB property deep.

**Hble 10 – 266**, OB left designated by PVC pipe markers in tall grass and by flags closer to the basket. OB property right. If your disc lands on/over the property on the right from the drive, proceed to marked drop zone with a penalty stroke. If OB left or deep of basket, normal OB rules apply. Parking lot is OB. Discs on top of the shipping containers are considered casual and relief can be taken from up to 1 meter from last point before landing on top.

**Hble 11 – 178**, Parking lot OB. If OB from drive, proceed to marked drop zone with penalty stroke. If OB again from drop zone, re-throw until lie is established in-bounds

**Hble 12 – 305**, Parking lot OB. Painted line behind stone blocks is OB. OB property right designated by fence posts- not wire. Playground is OB. Normal OB rules.



## FAQs

*Do I have to throw from the tee pad?*

No. You may throw from either side of the tee pads within the designated area if you deem the tee pad unsuitable for throwing. The front of the tee pad will serve as your tee pad and you are expected not to cross that while throwing.

*If I cross an island on my tee shot, do I go to the drop zone or throw from the nearest point it exited the island?*

On any and all island holes, you will throw from the drop zone unless you establish a lie in bounds and take a shot from in bounds. Otherwise, you continue to throw from the drop zone with normal penalty.

*How do I determine out of bounds between flags?*

To determine OB from between flags, the line is a straight line connecting the two closest flags. If any part of your disc is touching in bounds, you are safe. If none of your disc is touching in bounds, you are OB.

*For drop zones and OB, how do I score my hole?*

For drop zones and hazards, you count the number of actual throws you took and add the number of times you were penalized. For example: Throw 1 is OB missed island. Proceed to drop zone, throw 2 is parked under basket. Throw 3 is in the basket. You count your three throws and then add an additional stroke for going OB once.

*For holes with drop zones, can I just go straight to the drop zone?*

Yes, with a two-throw penalty. Per PDGA rule 806.02 G, you may proceed directly to any drop zone at the cost of two penalty throws.
